Car Broad sides Tri-State Ambulance



La Crosse Police are investigating an accident between a car full of teenagers and a Tri-State Ambulance.

The ambulance was transferring a patient just before midnight to Franciscan Skemp from Galesville. According to Tri-State Ambulance Director Matt Zavadsky, the ambulance was going south on George Street and went through the intersection of George and Gillette Streets when a car going east on Gillette drove through a red light and hit the right front side of the

ambulance.

Two 15-year-old girls in the front of the car were taken to Gundersen Lutheran with minor injuries. Two 16-year-old boys in the back of the car were not injured. The two paramedics and patient in the ambulance were not injured.
