RED – ISOLATE

• Fever (>100°F)	Report results to AOC	
<ul> <li>New unexplained cough</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Must wear mask</li> </ul>	
<ul> <li>Sore throat</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Must sanitize hands</li> </ul>	
<ul> <li>Feeling Unwell</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Must enter quarantine / isolation</li> </ul>	
<ul> <li>Shortness of breath</li> </ul>		
<ul> <li>Taking cold / flu medicine</li> </ul>		

<u>YELLOW - MONITOR</u>		
Signs / Symptoms	<u>Actions</u>	
<ul> <li>Low risk exposure within past 14 days</li> <li>Old explained cough</li> <li>Seasonal allergies</li> <li>Digestive symptoms</li> <li>Taking OTC antipyretics within past 8 hours and temp &lt;99.0°F</li> <li>Not taking antipyretics, NSAIDs, or steroids and temp between 99.0°F and 99.9°F</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Must wear a mask at work and repeat screening in 12 hours</li> <li>If symptoms develop during shift employee must sanitize hands and notify AOC</li> </ul>	

GREEN - NORMAL		
Signs / Symptoms	<u>Actions</u>	
<ul> <li>No symptoms</li> <li>Not taking antipyretics, NSAIDS, or steroids</li> <li>Temp &lt; 99.0°F</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>If symptoms develop during shift employee must don a surgical mask, sanitize hands, and notify AOC</li> </ul>	

## Returning to Work After Quarantine / Isolation (must meet all 3 criteria)

- 72 hours without fever and not taking antipyretics
- No symptoms
- 7 days since the onset of symptoms
